

Entertainment Facility (b) Event Facility

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Licensees are responsible to comply with all general liquor service terms and conditions; terms and conditions specific to the type of licence held; and any terms and conditions specific to the premises.

8.0 Entertainment Facility – General

8.1

Liquor must not be sold or served in the entertainment facility from:

- a) 2:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m.; and
- b) 2:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. on Remembrance Day.

8.2

The licensee must ensure that there is a variety of food available to patrons in the licensed premises at all times that the premises are open.

8.3

The licensee may provide food prepared outside the licensed premises or offer prepackaged food acceptable to the LGA.

9.0 Event Facility

9.1

The licensee may sell liquor for consumption in the licensed premises during an event the facility is primarily designed to present; and for a period of one hour before and after the event within the hours stated in 8.1, unless otherwise authorized by the LGA.

9.2

The licensee may upon authorization by the LGA, extend the time when liquor may be sold before and after an event in the licensed premises and/or sell liquor for consumption in the licensed premises at an authorized event other than what the facility is primarily designed to present.

9.3

The licensee may allow a minor to be present in the licensed premises unless the LGA has prohibited or restricted the presence of minors but the minor must not possess or consume liquor unless:

- a) the liquor is purchased or provided by his or her adult parent, spouse, common-law partner or guardian; and
- b) the liquor is consumed with a meal in the presence of the minor's adult parent, spouse, common-law partner or guardian.

9.4

If the licensee holds the entertainment facility licence for a movie theatre complex the licensee must ensure there are at least two theatres in the complex each holding at least 75 permanent seats.
