

# Entertainment Facility

## (a) Live Entertainment

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Licensees are responsible to comply with all general liquor service terms and conditions; terms and conditions specific to the type of licence held; and any terms and conditions specific to the premises.

## 8.0 Entertainment Venue – General

### 8.1

Liquor must not be sold or served in the entertainment facility from:

- a) 2:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m.; and
- b) 2:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. on Remembrance Day.

### 8.2

The licensee must ensure that there is a variety of food available to patrons in the licensed premises at all times that the premises are open.

### 8.3

The licensee may provide food prepared outside the licensed premises or offer prepackaged food acceptable to the LGA.

## 9.0 Entertainment - Live

### 9.1

The licensee must provide live entertainment approved by the executive director in the licensed premises in accordance with the following terms:

- a) the licensee must provide at least two hours of live entertainment in the premises each day the premises are open;
- b) The live entertainment must be provided between:
  - 12 noon and 8:00 p.m. on any day when the licensed premises close on or before 8:00 p.m.; or
  - 8:00 p.m. and 2:00 a.m. on any other day;
- c) the entertainment must be presented in a manner that is designed to draw the attention of all patrons;

- d) the entertainment must take place on a stage that is visible to all patrons and must constitute the main focus of the premises while it is being presented; and
- e) the entertainment must be provided by a performer who is paid by the licensee.

### 9.2

The licensee must ensure that all patrons leave the licensed premises within 60 minutes after the time when liquor sales must end in the licensed premises.

### 9.3

The licensee may only allow a minor to be present in the premises subject to an entertainment facility with live entertainment if the minor is accompanied by his or her parent, spouse, common-law partner or guardian who is at least 18 years of age.

### 9.4

The licensee must ensure the minor does not possess or consume liquor in the licensed premises unless:

- a) the liquor is purchased or provided by his or her adult parent, spouse, common-law partner or guardian; and
- b) the liquor is consumed with a meal in the presence of the minor's adult parent, spouse, common-law partner or guardian.

### 9.5

The licensee may allow a minor to provide entertainment in the age-restricted licensed premises if he or she is accompanied by his or her parent, spouse, common-law partner or guardian who is at least 18 years of age.
